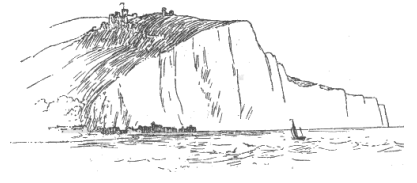


White Cliffs Of Dover
